

THE ALTARPIECES OF THE CHURCH OF SAINT-ROCH

The modest Romanesque church of Ternant has two 15th century altarpieces, donated by Philippe and Charles de Ternant, Knights of the Golden Fleece. True jewels of Flemish religious art, these triptychs each consist of a central panel in carved, painted and gilded wood and four wooden panels painted in (two side panels, two upper panels).

The oldest, the altarpiece of the Virgin represents episodes from the end of the life of the Virgin. As for the altarpiece of the Passion, it impresses first of all by its size, size (5.45 m x 2.38 m), then by the beauty of its representations.


Dedicated to the Passion of Christ, it shows scenes of Christ in the Garden of Olives, his Crucifixion, the Entombment, the Descent into Limbo (a state of the hereafter) and his Resurrection.

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- 1 From the church, take the path down to Coneuf. At the place, do not follow the road, but take the track on the left. Take the D 183 to the left for 150 m, then the track to the right, and the D 30 to the right for 250 m.
- 2 Take the track on the right. It leads to the front. Take the road to the left and reach a crossroads.
- 3 Cross the road, go past the cross and continue straight on to Lenteur. Cross the hamlet, then go up into the wood.
- 4 At the fork in the road, go left, cross the wood for 200 m and then take the path on the left for 1.5 km.
- 5 Go down to the left along the wood. At the T-junction, turn right and join Le Grand Satenot
- 6 [panorama on the Nivernais and Bourbonnais bocage] (Semi-open landscape by means of hedges, wooded banks and walls) Take the D30 to the left.
- 7 Turn right and follow the path for 500 m. Turn left towards Petit Satenot.
- 7 At the crossroads, take the track opposite in the direction of Les Brûlés and, just before the place, go down by the track on the left. At the fork in the road, go straight on and reach the Croix de Biche. Continue straight on along the road, past Les Sablons and go back to Ternant.
