PATRIMOINE / PATRIMONY

THE THERMAL BATHS OF SAINT-HONORÉ-LES-BAINS

Their origins date back to Antiquity. In 50 B.C., Roman legions discovered the existence of hot springs, and proceeded to the construction of thermal baths. After their destruction in the 5th century, the springs fell into oblivion for several centuries, and it was not until the 19th century for the thermal activity to revived with the purchase of the springs by the Marquis of Espeuilles. A huge establishment is then born. The consecration comes in 1860 when the springs were recognized as being of public utility.

The city then built numerous hotels to accommodate an ever-increasing ever-growing clientele, and developed leisure activities for the Parisian high society (theatre, casino). Today, the waters of Saint-Honoré are still very famous for their benefits.



Thermes

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- 1 From the tourist office, go up to the church, then go left at the crossroads. Cross the D 985 and continue along the road opposite. At the last houses, take the path that goes up into the wood.
- 2 Turn right. Go up the path. Cross the D 985 and go straight on. At the crossroads, turn right onto the D 157 for 150 m.
- 3 Take the path on the left. At the edge of the wood, fork right at the edge, then take the road on the left.
- 4 At the Soulins crossroads, take the road on the right, go left and then, at the crow's feet, go up on the right to the place called right to the place called Trucy.
- 5 Continue along the path on the right towards the Boiré pond. Follow the pond and go straight on to Achez. Take the D157 to the left for a few meters, then the road to the right.
- 6 After the house of La Milande, take the first road on the right. Take the road on the right towards Préporché to the first houses.
- 7 Take the path on the left at an acute angle for 2 km towards Saint Honoré-les-Bains. Take the road to the right, continue on the D 299 to the right and join the tourist office on the right.
