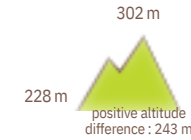

TO DISCOVER IN THE REGION

- Biches: Barrage à aiguilles de Fleury
- Needle Weir (usually built downstream of the river, preferably where the gradient is smallest) (19th century)
- Chamont fountain, commune of Biches (Sensitive sensitive natural area)
- Châtillon-en-Bazois: Port, castle and castle tower (11th century), garden classified as "remarkable garden"
- Montapas: swimming in the pond of La Chênaie

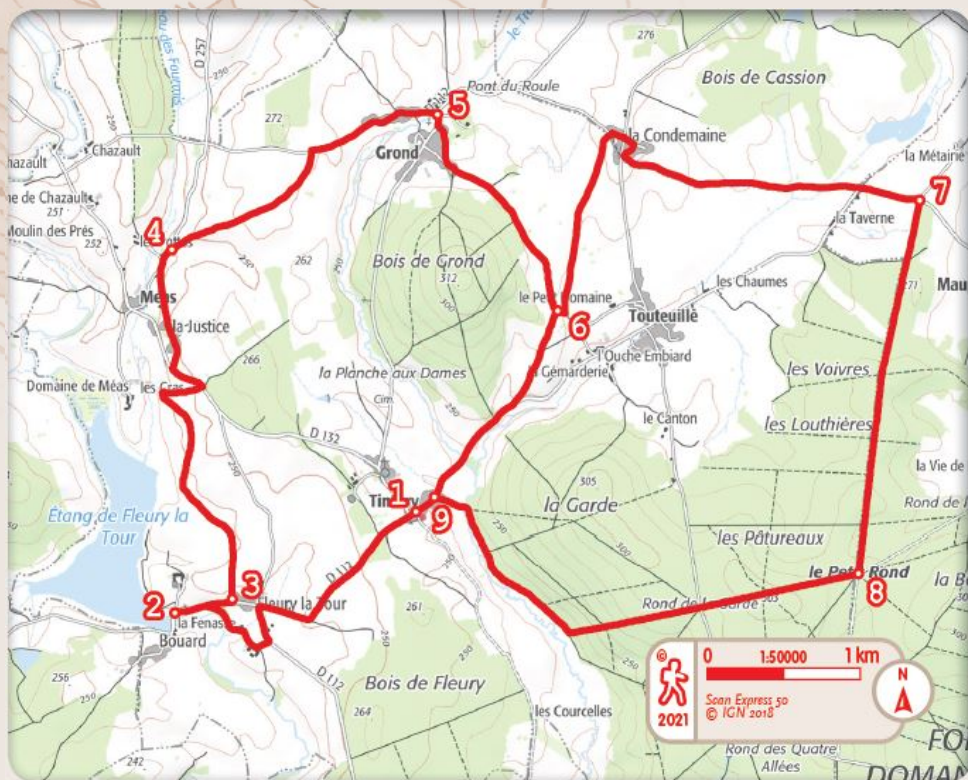


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Church of Tintury

HISTORY

pond of Fleury- la-Tour

The pond owes its name to the tower above it. It was created in the year 1000, drained in 1820 and reopened in 1991. This remarkable site, with a surface area of 60 ha, is fed by the river La Canne. It is not only a fishing place, but also a stopping place for migratory birds. It is home to a large number of animal species, such as the swans that have taken up residence there. The tower called "bonde de l'étang" dates from the 15th century, and was responsible for regulating the flow of the pond using a ball in the tailpiece. under the tower.

The legend says that a fantastic snake, the Vouavre, lives in the pond.

- 1 From the Tintury town hall turn left onto the D 112 towards Ferrèrve. At the intersection turn left and then right after 200 m. Go past the farm and join a track. At the crow's feet, take the one on the left which runs along the river Canne for 100 m. When you get back to the road, you can go back and forth to see the tower and the pond which is home to many species of birds.
- 2 Retrace your steps, at the crossroads take the road to the right of the calvary.
- 3 Take the path on the left to Les Cras, then turn right to join the D 132. Follow this one on the left. Turn right onto the D257, towards Perranges. Cross the hamlet of La Justice, and go straight on.
- 4 Turn right into the path, find the road, follow it to the right.
- 5 At the crossroads turn right, then turn left, the road becomes a path. Follow the road for 1200 m.
- 6 Continue to the left until you reach Condemaine. Follow the road to the right, at the end of the hamlet take the track on the left. When you reach the road, follow it slightly to the left.
- 6 Small variant (11km loop to the west and east) 6 Turn right, join the D 132 which will take you back to Tintury on the right. 9
- 7 At the crossroads with the "métairie brûlée", take the lane on the right. Continue straight ahead on the Grande Allée forest road.
- 8 At the Petit Rond take the first alley on the right and follow it straight on. At Rond de la Garde, cross a forest road and go down to the edge of the wood. Turn right and follow the stream of Touteuille. At the wash house, take the path on the left.
- 9 Take the road on the left to get back to the town hall of Tintury.
