This is a wonderful place to get together, enjoy gourmet experiences and share ideas about the very source of French identity itself and what makes the country so well-known across the globe.

Set off from Dijon to explore the area as you wish: the parks and gardens, the valleys and vineyards, or the famous Route des Grands Crus de Bourgogne (Route of the Great Burgundy Wines). You can also choose to take a leisurely wander along the Burgundy Canal either on foot or by bike.

Dijon is a modern tourist city which is fiercely proud of its heritage and which has been redesigned to take its natural setting and the environment into account.

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(The highlights of **dijon**

Dijon boasts 97 hectares of protected land, one of the biggest areas in France, is listed as a world heritage site by UNESCO and bears the French “Town of Art and History” label, making it a must-see of France. In this exceptional area, there are no less than 170 buildings and private mansions that are either classified or listed as historic monuments! This is the departure point of the Route des Grands Crus de Bourgogne (Route of the Great Burgundy Wines) and the Vallée Mondiale de la Gastronomie (Global Valley of Gastronomy), meaning that now more than ever, Dijon is the place to be for fans of good food and drink from all over the world.



Unmissable places

Visitors will enjoy the completely car-free town centre. Half-timbered houses, Roman and Gothic churches, 17th and 18th century mansions all line the medieval streets of the former capital of the Dukes of Burgundy.



Stroll around the historic centre

With five Michelin-starred restaurants, the lively town centre indoor market hall, an international food fair, and more than 1,200 shops in the town centre, some open seven days a week... Doesn't that make you want to go on a shopping spree in Dijon?

THE PALACE OF THE DUKES AND ESTATES OF BURGUNDY

It began as a fortress. It was built as a part of the defence system for the Gallo-Roman castrum. The building began to weaken and so was rebuilt from 1366 under the initiative of Philip the Bold, the first of the four dukes of Valois. Philip-the-Good would complete his grandfather's construction by adding the duke's residence and the Tour de la Terrasse, which bears his name today. In the 17th century, Jules Hardouin-Mansart, architect for the Château de Versailles, created the palace as we know it today. It now houses the tourist office, Dijon town hall and the Fine Arts Museum.

Guided tours are provided by the Tourist Office to discover the Palace of the Dukes.



THE FINE ARTS MUSEUM

The Fine Arts Museum of the city of Dijon has occupied the Palace of the Dukes and Estates of Burgundy since it first opened in 1799. It is one of the oldest and richest museums in France.

The museum's 50 rooms were completely transformed before this exceptional heritage site reopened in May 2019 to exhibit more than 1,500 artworks dating from Antiquity to the modern era.

This is a unique venue that you simply must visit!



PHILIPPE LE BON TOWER

The 316 steps lead to an exceptional panoramic view of the town and surrounding area. 46-metres high and built during Burgundy's most powerful era, the tower is a symbol of the town's reputation.

To be explored from top to bottom!



THE WELL OF MOSES

The Well of Moses can be found at the heart of the former charterhouse of Champmol, once the necropolis of the Dukes of Burgundy. It is a masterpiece of medieval Burgundian sculpture.

The Well of Moses is a realistic representation of the prophets from the Old Testament, and is a source of inspiration for many ancient and contemporary artists.

LES HALLES

The Market Halls of Dijon are a model of metallic elegance, and house 246 shops and 728 benches. It is always a pleasure to come here on Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays or Saturdays when it is devoted to gastronomy and terroir.

NOTRE DAME

The most ancient of Dijon's churches was built in 20 years, between 1230 and 1250. The façade has three levels, with dummy gargoyles and a jaquemart (bell-striking automaton) on the top. The automaton was brought back from Courtrai by the Duke Philip the Bold and has been displaying the time for the people of Dijon since 1383! On the left-hand side of the church of Notre Dame is a sculpture of the lucky owl of Dijon.

PRIVATE MANSIONS

The superb courtyards house some beautifully decorated façades. More than 100 private mansions were built in Dijon between the 15th and 18th centuries. Monumental gates and glazed roof tiles bear witness to both the wealth of the owners and the talent of the architects.



SAINT-BÉNIGNE CATHEDRAL

This symbol of Dijon can be seen as soon as you arrive on the train from Paris, and the polychrome roofing of Saint-Bénigne Cathedral is evidence of the glory years of Gothic Burgundy.

It was built onto the ruins of an ancient abbey church, of which only the crypt remains, a masterpiece of Roman art.



THE OWL TRAIL

Let the Owl guide you! Equipped with your booklet, follow the arrows and journey back in time! Come and discover the history of Dijon and admire the charm of the former capital of the Dukes of Burgundy! This fun and family-friendly trail has 22 steps, to take you on an exploration of the town's must-sees.

Many new projects have appeared and others are under way, including the transformation of the Fine Arts Museum, the development of the Consortium Museum and the creation of the Cité Internationale de la Gastronomie et du Vin.

The cultural scene of this unique city, built on a human scale, provides visitors with a fascinating insight into the world and the arts, and offers a marvellous opportunity to broaden their horizons.

Located in the former Palace of the Dukes and Estates of Burgundy, the Museum of Fine Arts was established in the eastern wing of the building at the end of the 18th century, when François Devosge founded the Drawing School. The Museum of Fine Arts offers visitors the opportunity to find out about an exceptionally rich heritage.

The permanent exhibition tour includes over 1,500 artworks ranging from Antiquity to the 21st century, with some masterpieces of medieval art, including the famous tombs of the Dukes of Burgundy and their procession of mourners, as well as artworks from great artists such as Rude, Delacroix, Monet, Pompon and Stael.

The Archaeological Museum houses evidence of a human presence in Burgundy from prehistoric times to the Middle Ages and is located in the heart of the ancient Benedictine Abbey of Saint-Bénigne.

The Jardin de l'Arquebuse is unlike any other garden in the world, offering a space where everyone is welcome to decipher and discuss natural sciences.

With a Planetarium, a Museum, a Botanical Garden and a new trail dedicated to food plants, the 'Jardin botanique des saveurs et des cépages, des origines à demain' (Botanical Garden of Flavours and Grape Varieties, from their origins to the future), this is Dijon's showplace for all manner of biodiversity.

Here you can observe, listen, understand, talk about the universe and about life... even talk about ourselves! This 5-hectare green setting carries the 'Ecojardin' (Ecogarden) label and lies at the very heart of the city, just a stone's throw from the Cité Internationale de la Gastronomie et du Vin, with a direct link to Dijon-Ville train station by an elegant footbridge.

Founded in 1977 and located at the heart of Dijon, the Consortium Museum has been dedicated to contemporary artistic creation and dissemination for over forty years, hosting exhibitions, concerts, screenings, performances and conferences. Located in a building 4,000 m² building designed by Japanese architect Shigeru Ban (Centre Pompidou-Metz, Pritzker Prize 2014) and his collaborator Jean de Gastines, the Consortium Museum is a veritable incubator for artistic experimentation and innovation. Each year, the Consortium Museum hosts temporary exhibitions by international artists, and also display artworks from its permanent collection.

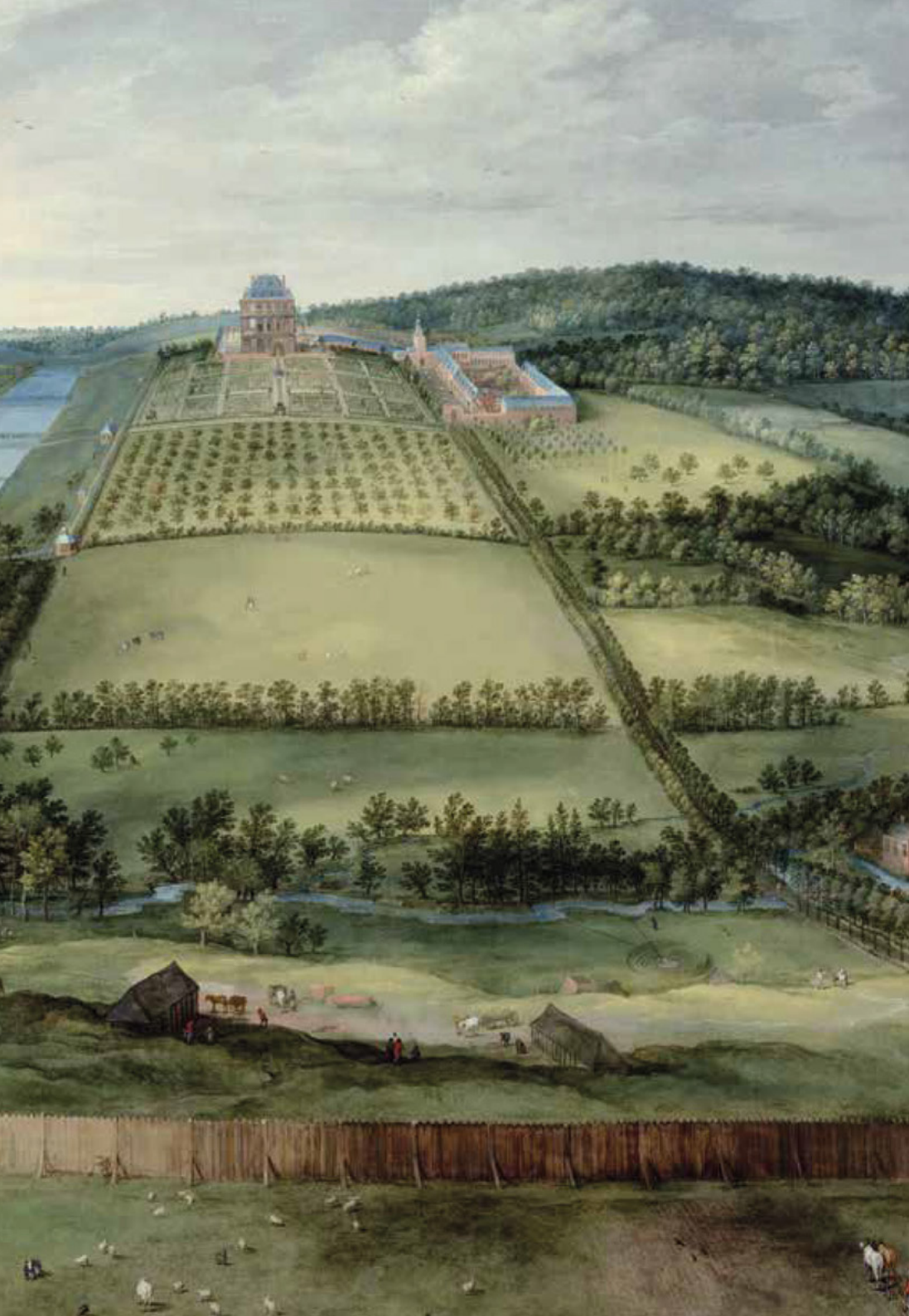

Gourmet destination

Dijon alone offers all the ingredients for an unforgettable epicurean break. It's hardly surprising that Dijon was chosen as the gateway to the Vallée de la Gastronomie, with 5 Michelin-starred chefs, a host of gastronomic and bistro-style restaurants and countless local specialities (marbled ham, gingerbread, snails, crème de cassis, gougères...), Dijon is a beacon for indulgence, gourmet foods and great wines.

Mustard

Mustard is a typical condiment of Dijon, which was already very popular during the glory days of the Dukes of Burgundy. Today, it bears the Protected Geographic Indication “Moutarde de Bourgogne”..



Crème de cassis

Crème de cassis is a sweet liqueur that first appeared in Dijon in the 19th century, and is a key ingredient of the Kir® cocktail. Originally, the blackcurrant bushes were planted at the end of the vines, to make local ratafia, the predecessor of liqueur. Crème de cassis is made by soaking Burgundy blackcurrants in alcohol, and then adding sugar.

Gingerbread

Gingerbread was imported from Flanders by the Dukes of Burgundy, and the Dijon version is flavoured with aniseed and citrus fruits. Make sure you try the “nonnettes” while you’re here. They are delicious little gingerbread cakes made with orange marmalade and honey, in the past made by the nuns in the convent.

THE DIJON COURTHOUSE

The recently restored Palais de Justice is now open to the public.

Relive the history of the Dijon Court of Appeal on a 1h45 guided tour guided tours.

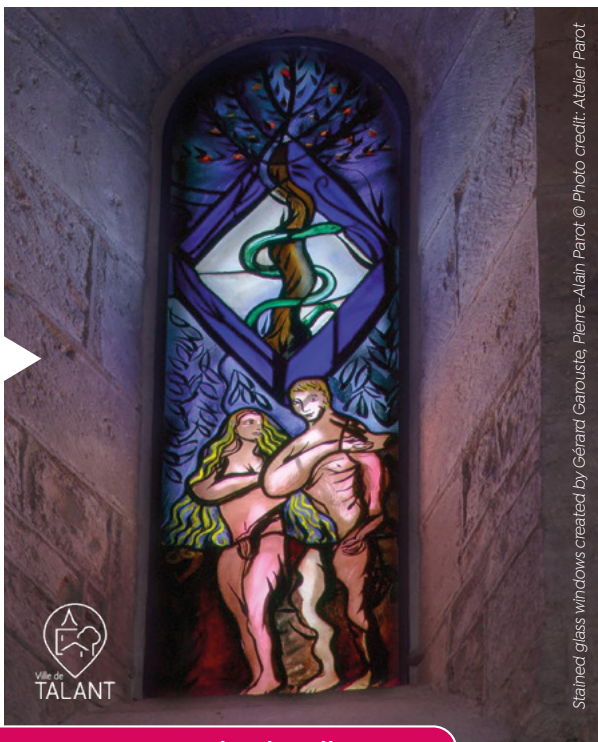

THE TALANT FORTRESS AND ITS CHURCH

Travel back in time by exploring the medieval Talant at the time of the Dukes of Burgundy. An impregnable fortress perched on its rocky outcrop, the city of the Capetian dukes and its now-vanished castle played a decisive role in the history of the capital of Dijon. You'll appreciate the remains of the fortifications and endless landscape that stretches away from this hill, as well as the Notre-Dame Church, a 13th-century stone backdrop built by the Capetian dukes of Burgundy and its stained-glass windows created by the artist Gérard Garouste

in the 1980s.

Wine Tourism destination

As the departure point for the famous Route des Grands Crus de Bourgogne (Route of the Great Wines of Burgundy), Dijon has always been a winemaking town. The beautiful wine merchant houses throughout the town are proof of that, as well as the statue of the vintager overlooking the fountain at the Place François Rude. With the listing of the “Climats, Terroirs of Burgundy” as World Heritage by UNESCO in 2015, the winemaking industry of Dijon rose from the ashes. The many wine bars and wine cellars throughout the town showcase the excellence and unique characteristics of Burgundian wines.

The revival of the Dijon vineyards

Today, the vineyards of Dijon have been revived thanks to the new vines that were planted on the Dijon hillsides. Two and a half hectares of vineyards will be devoted to the Pinot Noir and Chardonnay Conservatory, to identify which plants adapt best to the changes in climate.



Local winegrowing areas

Dijon Métropole will be replanting 50 hectares of vines in the 300 hectares of referenced land for AOC Bourgogne. There are four winegrowing zones there: La Cras, Montrecul, Les Marcs-d'Or and La Rente Giron.

The vineyard in Marsannay-la-Côte and Chenôve has its very own appellation with over 350 hectares of vines.

Discover the “Climats” of Burgundy

Of all the winegrowing regions of France, Burgundy has the highest number of registered designations of origin (AOC). Divided into four categories, the vintage appellations, known as “climats” are the most prestigious ones.

Even though the most well-known Burgundy wines are from the Côte de Nuits and Côte de Beaune vineyards, Dijon Métropole would like to restore the “Côte de Dijon” to its former glory and add it to the Route des Grands Crus (Route of the Great Wines).

The nearest car park to the welcome desk on Rue des Forges with spaces for disabled people is the Trémouille car park (paying) located 160m from the entrance to the tourist office on Rue de la Préfecture. People with reduced mobility can ask to be dropped off by a relative in the pedestrian zone by explaining their situation at the entrance terminals.
