HISTORY

The hills of the Morvan cultivate the art of welcome

A beautiful hilly bocage (semi-open landscape by means of hedges. hedgerows and walls or bocage) : developed in a soft granite, the hills of the Luzvcois bear one of the best preserved bocages of Burgundy-Franche-Comté. Walking along the secret paths, hikers can enjoy panoramas of the high forested massif of Mont Beuvray. An ancient country focused on others and on the future: the barony of Luzy was only annexed to the Nivernais in 1418 and was equipped with ramparts (tower of the barons). In the town hall, go and see "The Life of Esther".

a beautiful Aubusson tapestry. Luzy now plays the attractiveness card. Its cultural dynamism has spread across the borders of the Bazois-Loire-Morvan. A gentle transition between small town and nature: the Alene trail and the garden of the future. From the church, the Alene educational trail passes by, which has been restored to its natural bed, thanks to the Fishermen's Association. The garden is an atypical family space, on the banks of the Alène, a cosy and shared place in the middle of nature, a stone's throw from the city centre.

TO DISCOVER ON THE WAY

- St Peter's Church 19th century
- ramparts 14th century fortified house of the Lords of Montarmin 14th or 15th
- château des Moindrots late 19th or early 20th century (private, cannot be visited)
- meanders of the river Alène
- view of the Monts du Morvan and the Saône et Loire -view of the Moulin Neuf quarry in Fléty, providing road stones and railway ballast providing.



TO DISCOVER IN THE REGION

- -Luzy: Aubusson tapestries from the 18th century (at the Hôtel de -Town Hall), 14th century Barons' Tower (local history museum) history museum)
 Romanesque churches in Avrée, Millay, Poil, Savigny-Poil-Fol, Sémelay (Cluny site)
 Lanty: Former school, Romanesque church of the Nativity of the Virgin Mary in the 12th century, the sacred fountain of the Good-Dame, object of pilgrimage
 Larochemillay: Village, La Roche castle (private), the Tower, Fréchots scrub, Mont Touleur
 Saint Léger- souis- Benyray: Bibracte and Mont Benyray
- Saint Léger- sous- Beuvray: Bibracte and Mont Beuvray - La Boulaye: Buddhist temple



1 From the tourist office, take the Cours Gambetta to reach the D 981 (avenue Marceau) and turn left.

Small variant (south-east loop: 8.6 km, north-west loop: 9.6 km)

- Turn right along the D 981 and then left for 90 m along the D 973. Take the first first small road on the left to reach the Priory and then St André by turning right at the next crossroads.
- 2 Drive along the church, turn right at Place du Colombier and then left at the bottom of Rue de la Perrière.
- [> Remparts de Luzy Turn right into rue des prés Graillets, then right into the footpath. Follow the right bank of the the Alène. Turn right at the end of the path. Cross the Alène and follow the left bank. Take the path on the left after the farm of Montarmin
- () [> Montarmin farm
- Turn right at the edge of the wood
- (*) [> Panoramas, view of the Morvan mountains, Mont Touleur and Mont Beuvray After the ridge path, turn left, then at the intersection, the first path on the right. Take the path in between the house and the D27.
 - At the intersection, take the road on the left, cross the D 973
 - (> follow it on the right for 100 m caution) and take the first path on the left. At the crossroads turn right. Go straight on at the edge of the wood. At the crossroads, turn right onto the road and left.
 - Cross the D 981
 - (> Be careful), follow it for a few metres on the west side and take the road on the right. At the intersection with the road, cross it and continue straight on.
 - **6** Go back down to the right, along the Château des Moindrots. Continue straight on the road.
 - Turn left at the crossroads after the farm, then right after 100m. Turn left, then right before the private road. Turn left into Rue Ledru Rollin, then into Rue du Vieux Pont
